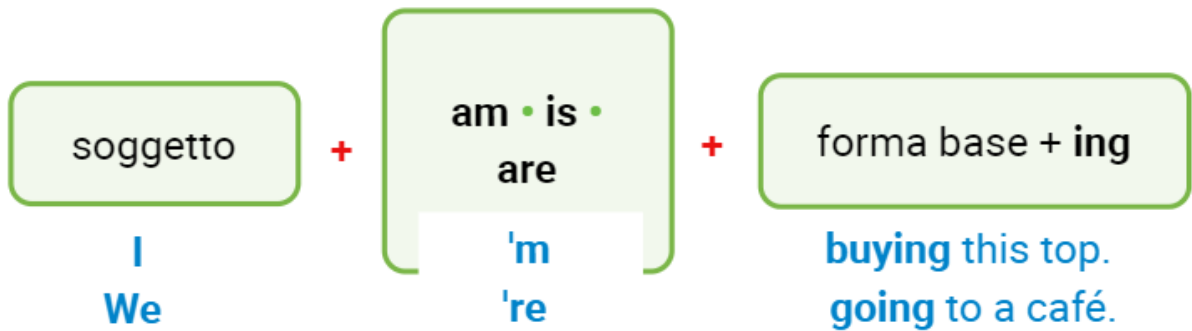


# Present Continuous – Mrs. M



Il **present continuous** descrive azioni che avvengono nel momento in cui si parla.

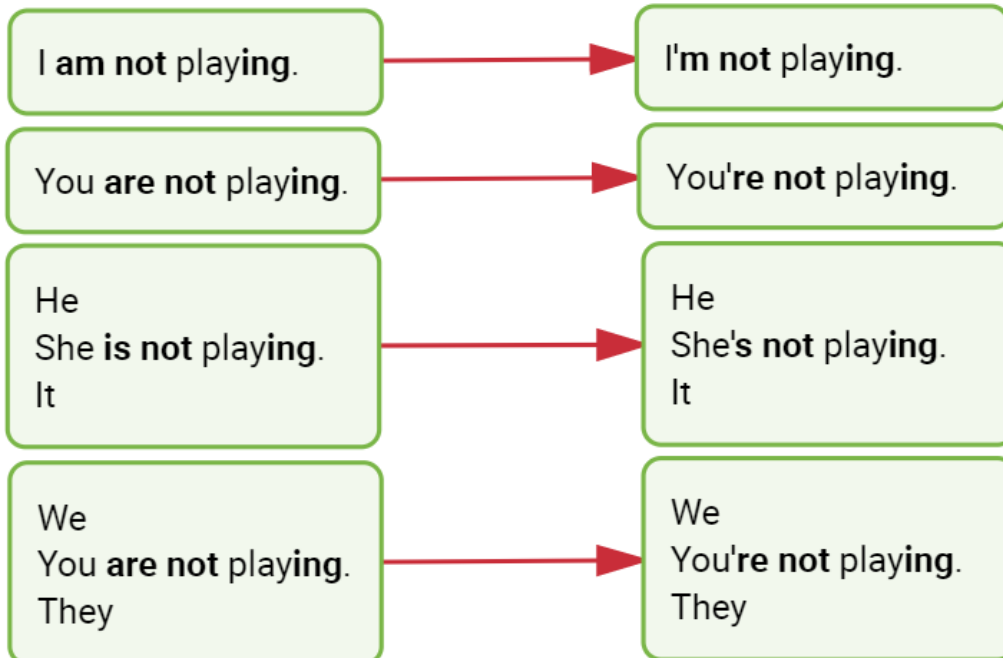
# Forma Negativa

# Forma Interrogativa

Am • Is • Are + soggetto + forma base + ing  
Are you coming?

Yes, + soggetto + am • is • are  
Yes, we are.

No, + soggetto + 'm not • isn't • aren't  
No, we aren't.

interrogative

short answers  
affirmative negative

Am I playing?  
Are you playing?  
Is he playing?  
Is she playing?  
Is it playing?  
Are we playing?  
Are you playing?  
Are they playing?

Yes, you are.	No, you aren't.
Yes, I am	No, I'm not.
Yes, he is.	No, he isn't.
Yes, she is.	No, she isn't.
Yes, it is.	No, it isn't.
Yes, we are.	No, we aren't.
Yes, you are.	No, you aren't.
Yes, they are.	No, they aren't.

# Present simple vs Present Continuous

What **are you** guys **doing** here?

**We're shopping.**

Il **present continuous** descrive un'azione in corso nel momento in cui si parla.

Si usa con espressioni di tempo quali **now, right now, at the moment.**

I **never wear** pink.

Il **present simple** descrive azioni abituali e dati di fatto. Si usa con avverbi ed espressioni di frequenza quali **always, never, every day, once a week, ecc.**
